INTRODUCING SF PENINSULA ROTARY MEANS BUSINESS (SFPRMB)

February 27th, 2014

SFPRMB is a collaboration of SF Peninsula businesspeople who believe Rotarians should honor the roots of our great worldwide organization, and support one another in business. We know that prosperous Rotarians donate more time and financial resources to local and International projects than Rotarians who are struggling to make overhead. RMB is designed to increase the business opportunities for all Rotarians, and in so doing, expand the good work Rotary does, worldwide.

We're very excited to introduce a revolutionary approach to RMB, which is centered around the 18 clubs on the San Francisco Peninsula. In this rotational model, each monthly RMB networking event is hosted by a different Peninsula club. The SFPRMB team takes care of promoting the events (including facilitating networking exercises), works with the clubs to help organize the events, provides RSVP services online, handles the finances, provides wine, and pays all of the expenses (up to \$15 per attendee).

In 2013, SFPRMB facilitated RMB events hosted by the Foster City, SSF, San Mateo, San Mateo Sunrise, Mid-Peninsula Evening (Provisional), Menlo Park and Pacifica clubs. So far in 2014, Foster City, Burlingame, Belmont and SF International Airport have stepped up, with several other clubs planning to host events later on in the year.

The numbers attending the events continue to rise, with 39 attending the Foster City event in January, 2014, and 44 attending the February, 2014 event in Burlingame, at which 14 Rotary clubs were represented, and at which six young prospective Rotarian business professionals engaged Rotary.
